The term "Test of Time" has never been truer for Atlantic Center for the Arts as we celebrate two milestones this year.

The Florida Chapter of the American Institute of Architects awarded Thompson and Rose Architects—now Charles Rose Architects of Boston—its prestigious AIA Florida Design Award for 2022. The Leeper Studio Complex, named for Atlantic Center for the Arts founder Doris Leeper, has received the "Test of Time" award. The award recognizes a distinguished work of architecture, after 25 years, for its aesthetic statement and execution and that, by the timelessness of its design, has influenced architecture or building type. The Leeper Studio Complex, built by Epoch Properties of Winter Park, Florida, includes music, painting, sculpture, dance and writing studios; a 200-seat black-box theater; media lab; and library—a successful union of award-winning architecture and nature. We're grateful to our many supporters who funded the Leeper Studio Complex at its inception, including Volusia County's ECHO grant and the State of Florida, Division of Arts and Culture, and proud to say this is ACA's 9th architectural award.

"Our design is attuned to the interdisciplinary focus of the program and seeks to foster the immersion of the artist into the sub-tropical, dense and richly textured landscape," said Charles Rose, FAIA. "An elevated boardwalk connects each studio pavilion, creating spaces for conversation and collaboration as people move among the pavilions in the complex." FAIA and the Orlando Foundation for Architecture are sponsoring an open house at ACA on Saturday, October 8, from 10 AM to 2 PM. This event is free and open to the public.

Integrating the natural environment and architecture and incorporating an interdisciplinary and mentorship approach to its residencies was core to Leeper's vision as an artist and environmentalist. ACA has inspired tens of thousands of artists since its first residencies in 1982. This year, ACA is celebrating 40 years of our world-renowned residency program, another "Test of Time" milestone.

Community support has been essential to the successes that we celebrate, and what a joy it is to continue to welcome you to the world and work of our unique programs. We have established an archiving fund so that our history can be preserved and have now converted 152 films from our early programming days, as well as countless documents and photographs. We look forward to sharing this rich archive with you as we celebrate "The Test of Time!"

Defiantly charismatic, the Zimbabwean-born choreographer Nora Chipaumire has long been a kind of rock star of dance.
